F33 Fire Prevention and Plan



Beware of fire hazards.

Cooking, heating, electrical outlets, cigarettes, and candles are common fire hazards. SMOKING & CANDLE USE IS STRICTLY PROHIBITED

Fire alarms.

The smoke alarms every tested on each caravan occupant change. The batteries are replaced every year. Upon hearing the alarm KNOW WHAT TO DO below

Know what to do.

The fire escape plan with exit point is the main entrance/exit to the caravan. This is your emergency exit. Windows are openable in all of the living/sleeping spaces

Upon Discovering a Fire

- Evacuate all persons as far away as possible from the emergency
- Make one attempt to put out the fire if you feel confident & only if it is safe to do so
- Dial 999 and ask for the Fire Brigade
- If necessary, alert any neighbours to the emergency via the external alarm

Ask for help.
